

## **Castor Wheels Disclaimer**

Brandline does not provide warranty cover against castors fitted to its planters.

Heavy duty industrial castors are fitted as standard with each castor having a minimum downward loading weight of 150kg which is more than sufficient for the weight of any planter, even when fully filled.

Castors are designed to work on level floors such as warehousing, factories etc. On these surfaces the castors will provide continuous service. Castors are not designed to function on uneven surfaces that incorporate cobbles, steps, kerbs, potholes, paving slabs etc. Any uneven flooring with drops or places where the wheels can catch will damage the castor.

The momentum created by a moving planter will apply excessive lateral pressure on the castor joint, should the movement of the planter be suddenly interrupted, and the planter is forced to stop.

If it is necessary for a planter to be moved up or down a step, a ramp should be placed in position prior to the planter being moved.

To help planters traverse bumpy, uneven ground as much as possible, Brandline uses larger 100mm wheels.

Whilst it is recommended that planters remain static, if they do need to be moved, the best option is to supply planters fitted with 90mm high legs to allow the insertion of a pallet truck.

Whilst the fitting of castors is offered as an option, it is carried out entirely at the client's risk.

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
